From Caterpillars to Butterflies—90% Achieve Reading Proficiency.

Our core program focuses on literacy, numeracy, and academic support for young people, who come to the center from Monday to Friday. We are proud to share the remarkable success of our program, which has significantly impacted the lives of these children in our communities.

Our after-school literacy program, conducted daily in our conducive Hanpet, KiNiKi, and other learning spaces, serves 124 beneficiaries, equipping them with essential skills. We are excited to announce that 90% of our participants, who initially struggled with reading, are now proficient readers. This success is largely attributed to your support, our dedicated staff, and the highly effective Jolly Phonics method.

The success of our after-school project led to high demand for a preschool program, which we launched in 2022. With over 200 applications for just 30 spots, our preschool program has also seen significant achievements, with 60% of preschoolers already reading and writing. We plan to graduate these preschoolers in September 2024, preparing them for enrollment in community day schools.

Looking ahead, we plan to focus on intensive English-speaking activities to further enhance our students' skills. Together, we are building a brighter future for our community, addressing the literacy gap, and providing quality education to more children.


Preserving The Past And Protecting The Wild


